ELIMINATION OF GRACE PERIOD FOR OSHA OUTREACH TRAINERS

The OSHA Directorate of Training and Education has announced a change of the elimination of grace period afforded to outreach instructors in maintaining their trainer authorization. The new change will take effect January 1, 2019, the 90-day grace period will be eliminated and the requisite update course must be completed BEFORE the expiration date indicated on the trainer's card. If authorization lapses, not only must the individual retake the Trainer Course (OSHA 500 or 501) in order to once again be authorized to

conduct the 10- and 30-hour outreach classes, but will be subject to meeting all prerequisites of becoming a trainer, up to and including completing the applicable Standards course.

This change will be included in the next published revisions of the OSHA Outreach Training Program Requirements and applicable sections of each Industry Procedures document, and will become effective January 1, 2019.
