HATE OSHA PAPERWORK?

- **Want to shape policy? Here's your chance!**

Federal OSHA is requesting public comment on their current methodology of gathering data from employers. They are particularly interested in:

- Whether the proposed information collection requirements are necessary for the proper performance of the agency's (OSHA) functions, including whether the information is useful;

- The accuracy of OSHA's estimate of the burden (time and costs) of the information collection requirements, including the validity of the methodology and assumptions used;
- The quality, utility, and clarity of the information collected; and
- Ways to minimize the burden on employers who must comply—for example, by using automated or other technological information collection and transmission techniques.
- In the past decade, public comments on this topic were requested 3 times, but only 5 total comments have been provided nationwide. Your input will almost certainly be read and likely used to inform changes to OSHA paperwork requirements if submitted.
- The deadline for submission is December 20, 2021.
