13th Annual Future Safety Leaders Golf Outing Friday, July 25, 2025

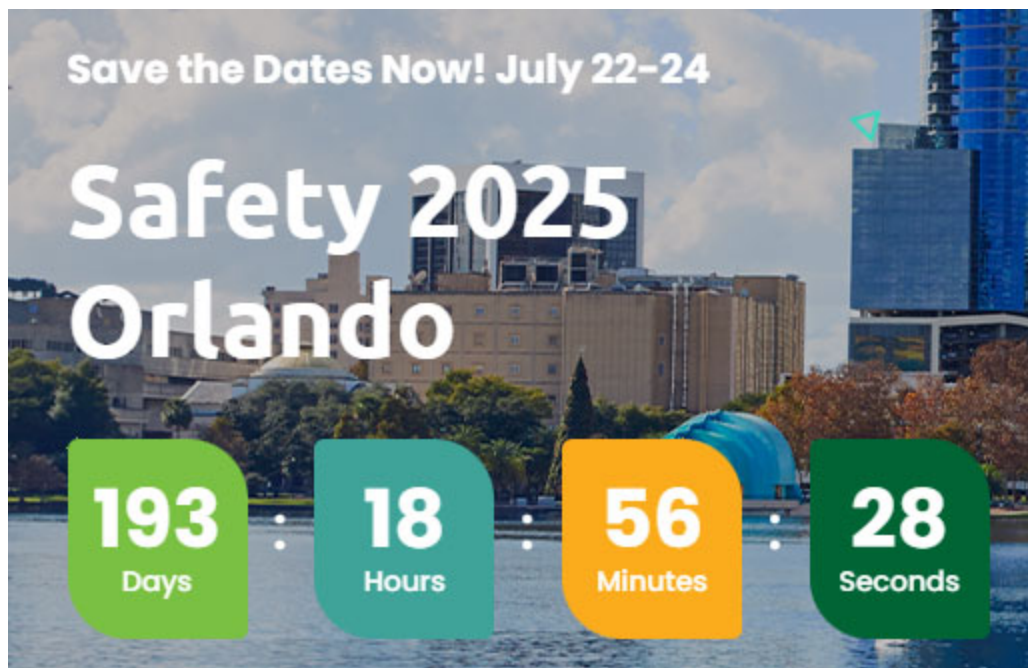

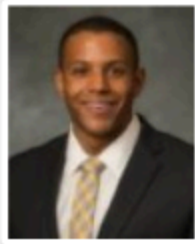
