July is National Fireworks Safety Month

July brings warmer weather, backyard bar-b-ques, fun, family, and FIREWORKS! But every year, firework-related incidents are bad enough that medical treatment is required. Additionally, fireworks are responsible for nearly 19,000 fires each year!

Our work as safety professionals doesn't stop at the office. As consumers of fireworks, whether we choose to watch them or set them off ourselves, we must ensure we are doing so safely.

The National Safety Council shares the following tips:

Never allow young children to handle fireworks

- Older children should use them only under close adult supervision
- Never use fireworks while impaired by drugs or alcohol
- Anyone using fireworks or standing nearby should wear protective eyewear
- Never hold lighted fireworks in your hands
- Never light them indoors
- Only use them away from people, houses and flammable material
- Never point or throw fireworks at another person
- Only light one device at a time and maintain a safe distance after lighting
- · Never ignite devices in a container
- Do not try to re-light or handle malfunctioning fireworks
- Soak both spent and unused fireworks in water for a few hours before discarding
- Keep a bucket of water nearby to fully extinguish fireworks that don't go off or in case of fire
- · Never use illegal fireworks
